
Drug use in teens in 2004:

Since 1975, the Monitoring the Future Survey has annually studied the extent of drug abuse among high school students. Here are some numbers from their 2004 study:

Oxycontin yearly use was at 1.7% for 8th graders, 3.5% for 10th graders and 5% for 12th graders.

Methamphetamine yearly use was at 1.5% for 8th graders, 3% in 10th graders and 3.4% in 12th graders.

Marijuana 30 day use was at 6.4% for 8th graders, 15.9% for 10th graders and 19.9% for 12th graders.

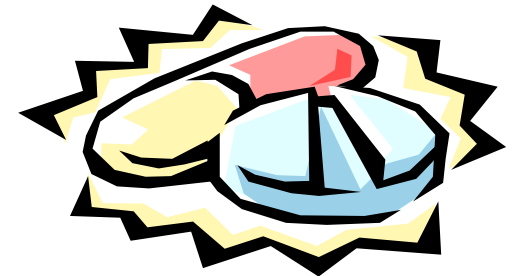

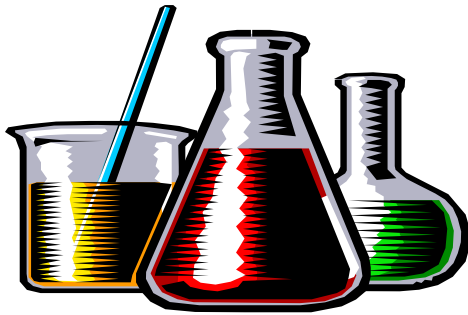

What drugs we test for:

We find that the most effective panel for high school drug testing is as follows:

Marijuana

Opiates

Cocaine

Benzodiazepines

Amphetamine

Some school corporations also test for *Alcohol* and *Nicotine*. Negative results are received in 24 hours, except nicotine which can take up to 3 days. Positive results are received within 2

Our Procedure:

Work-Comp Management Services follows DOT (Department of Transportation) guidelines for all of our drug screen collections. We focus on decreasing student anxiety levels during the screening procedure. WCMS's staff believes the drug screening process does not have to be an uncomfortable one. Our staff members go to great lengths to make the process discreet and secure. All of our staff is DATIA (Drug and Alcohol Testing Industry Association) certified in urine and alternate specimen collection. We have a Medical Review Officer at our clinic to review all positive results.
